**Sector: Non-profit organization**

**Organization:** Peace and Sport is an international, neutral and independent organization based in Monaco, which promotes peace using the power of sport. Founded in 2007 by Modern Pentathlon Olympic Medallist and World Champion Joël Bouzou, Peace and Sport enjoys the High Patronage of H.S.H. Prince Albert II of Monaco.

**Mission and activities:** the mission and activities of this internship, under the supervision of the Communication and Press Manager, are as follow:

**1. Digital communication**

- Animation and enlargement of the community on social networks: develop graphic content - posts, visuals, video animation - feed a monthly editorial planning, ensure the follow-up of publications, analyze the audience
- Identify new formats and propose engaging communication concepts
- Update of the website and posting of articles and press releases
- Participate in the development of new digital tools (leaflets, posters...)
- Mailing lists management

**2. Specific project : April6 mobilization**

The selected person will support the development and implementation of the #WhiteCard campaign 2022. The #WhiteCard campaign is a mass social media campaign launched by Peace and Sport in support of the International Day of Sport for Development and Peace celebrated on April 6.

- Execute a social media strategy for Peace and Sport digital campaigns
- Create a digital buzz around digital and social media campaigns
- Design adapted graphic contents for social media
- Monitoring and evaluation of digital tools impact

**Desired skills and experience:**

- Degree in communications, journalism, marketing or equivalent.
- Demonstrated ability to produce multimedia materials for traditional, digital platforms and social media campaigns.
- Excellent written and verbal communication in French and English – Mandatory.
- Excellent command of DTP software (Adobe Creative Suite) – Mandatory.
- Good organisational and planning skills.

- Excellent writing, editing and proofreading skills.
- Prior experience in the humanitarian, NGO, development sector- ideal, but not required.
